

# **TURF TALK**

This month I want to talk about Traffic and how it affects golf course conditions. It is one of the biggest problems we face at Smithfields Country Club.

Traffic on a golf course can come from a multitude of places. Examples are golfers, carts, and maintenance equipment. These things over time can significantly impact the turf's growing conditions and overall health. The repeated pressure exerted on the grass blades and soil can lead to compaction, which restricts air and water movement within the soil profile. Over time, areas that experience high traffic, such as putting greens, tee boxes, and fairways, can develop bare spots and uneven surfaces, detracting from the course's aesthetic and functional quality.

Traffic-induced compaction can result in firmer, less resilient turf, affecting the ball's behavior upon landing and rolling. Ensuring smooth consistent turf conditions is essential for maintaining the quality of play expected by the membership. Therefore, managing traffic and mitigating its effects are crucial for preserving the course's playability.

To address the challenges posed by traffic we implement various management strategies aimed at reducing compaction and promoting healthy turf. Regular aeration is the most common practice, to alleviate compaction and improve air and water infiltration. Additionally, restricting cart usage during wet conditions and spreading cart traffic over larger areas to allow for turf recovery. By everyone doing their part to abide by cart rulings and avoiding weaker turf areas we can greatly improve the overall health and playability of the golf course.
