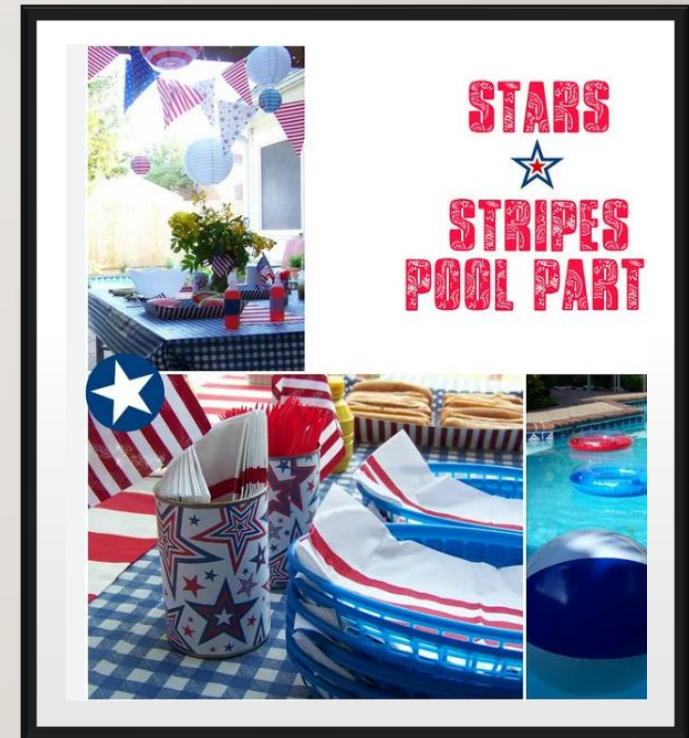

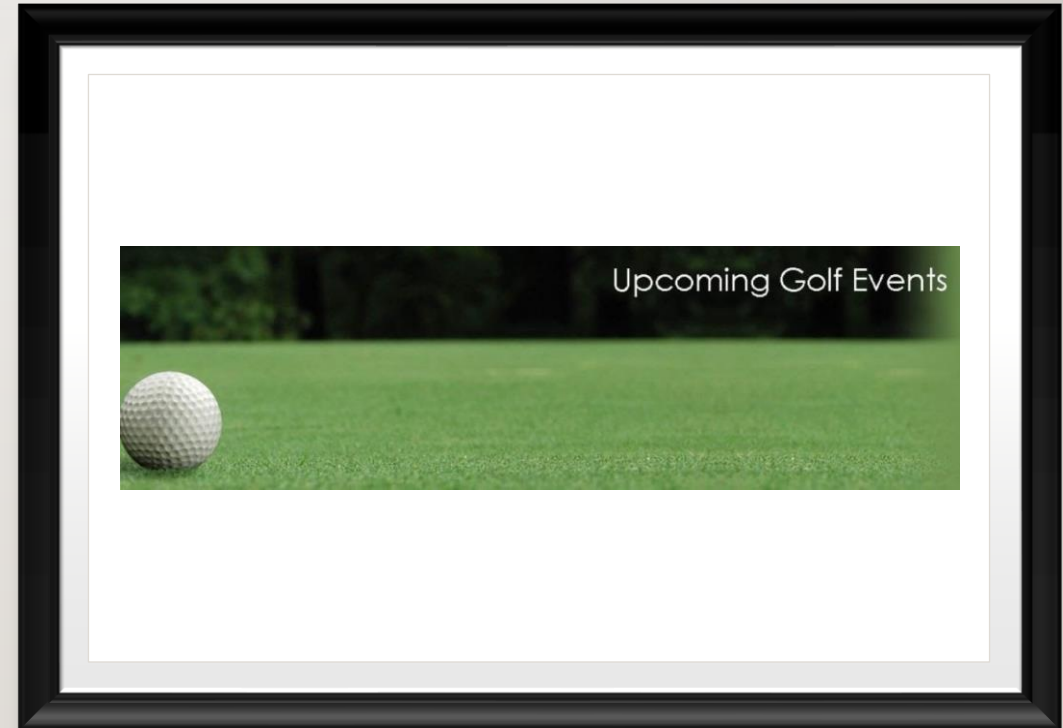

GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH!

Become a GREAT PUTTER

To become a great putter, you must work on fundamentals and consistency.

- -Develop a consistent stance, grip, and posture.
- -Practice distance control by hitting putts from various lengths and slopes.
- -Focus on a smooth, pendulum-like stroke with a steady head and minimal hand movement.
- -Aim for a consistent ball position and strike the ball in the center of the putter face.
- -Read greens carefully and visualize the ball's path before putting. Practice regularly to build confidence and familiarity with different greens.
- Emphasize mental focus and stay positive even after misses.
- -Learning to manage pressure and maintaining a calm mindset are vital for becoming a great putter.
