


NEW YEAR'S EVE PARTY

GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH!

The Bunker Shot!

Mastering the art of hitting a bunker shot is a crucial skill in golf, and it requires a combination of technique, precision, and confidence. Follow these key steps to improve your bunker play and increase your chances of success:

- 1. **Proper Setup:** Begin by selecting the appropriate club, usually a sand wedge or lob wedge. Open the clubface slightly to increase the bounce and prevent it from digging into the sand. Position the ball slightly forward in your stance, and distribute your weight evenly on both feet.
- 2. **Dig Your Feet In:** To establish a stable base, dig your feet into the sand. This helps create a solid foundation and prevents slipping during the swing. Make sure your stance is slightly wider than usual.
- **3. Visualize Your Shot:** Before you swing, visualize the trajectory and distance you want to achieve. Picture the ball landing softly on the green. This mental preparation helps build confidence and focus.
- **4. Maintain a Light Grip:** Grip the club with a lighter-than-normal grip pressure. This allows the clubhead to glide through the sand smoothly.
- 5. **Swing Technique:** Focus on a shallow, sweeping motion rather than a steep, digging swing. Aim to strike the sand a couple of inches behind the ball. Keep the clubhead accelerating through the sand, maintaining a smooth and even tempo.
- **6. Follow Through:** A proper follow-through is crucial for bunker shots. Allow the clubhead to continue its path after impact, finishing high. This ensures a clean and crisp contact with the sand.
- 7. Practice Regularly: Bunker shots require practice to develop a feel for the sand and perfect your technique. Spend time in the practice bunker, experimenting with different setups and swings to find what works best for you.
