
AROUND THE CLUB

TURF TALK CONT.

In February, the saying "if you don't like the weather, give it a minute, it will change" proved particularly true. We experienced fluctuating temperatures, ranging from 70-degree days to 40-degree days. Fortunately, we were spared from excessive rainfall this month, which is a relief. Our maintenance team has been hard at work, establishing new mulch beds around holes 18 and behind the 8th green. Additionally, we completed our spring pre-emergent application and dedicated considerable time to pruning trees to enhance both the visual appeal and playability of the course.

Looking ahead to this month, we have several significant projects on the agenda. Our primary focus will be addressing the greenside bunkers on holes 10 and 11. This involves removing accumulated mud, replacing damaged liners, and replenishing the sand. We'll also continue our tree pruning efforts and refine existing mulch beds. Lastly, we'll devote attention to clearing away gumballs from the sweet gum trees.

With the recent warmer weather, we're seeing a surge in green grass growth. Please be patient with us as this may slightly impact greens speeds in the coming weeks. As the greens awaken from their winter dormancy, maintaining consistent speeds becomes more challenging. Rest assured, we're working diligently to fine-tune them. As always, I value any feedback you may have and eagerly anticipate welcoming you back to the course.



GOLF TIP OF THE MONTH!

Avoid Three Putts

Putting seems like it should be one of the easiest parts of the game, but it's not. Three putts are something that can plague a golfer of any skill level and if you can get through an entire round without one, you've done something right. When it comes to putting, speed is far more important than direction and if you learn how to control your pace, you won't have any of those testy 4-footers coming back for par.

If you've been struggling with your putting, throw down a few balls on the practice green before your next round. Aim at a hole 3 or 4 feet away and don't stop until you make 10 in a row. If you miss one, start over. After a while, those short little knee knockers will be much easier to make.
